- 1. Call to Order: 7:04pm

  - d. Rink Boards were delivered. We should look for ice and a couple volunteers to put them together prior to first use to ensure everything goes together without issue.
  - e. Registration Numbers Update discussed. Midget has a large number of goalies, Mark will contact Bonnyville Minor Hockey to see if they are in need of goaltenders and explore options.
  - f. Coach Interview and Selection needs to be scheduled. Everyone agrees that the week of Sept 9-13 works for their schedules. There will be 5 people present on the interview panel for each division, Connie will ensure there are copies of each application available for all panel members to view. Coach applicants at each level are currently Initiation 3, Novice 3 (Liz has a few more), Atom 9, Peewee 11, Bantam 2, Midget 5, Female Atom 2, Female Peewee 2, Female Bantam 1 and Female Midget 3.
